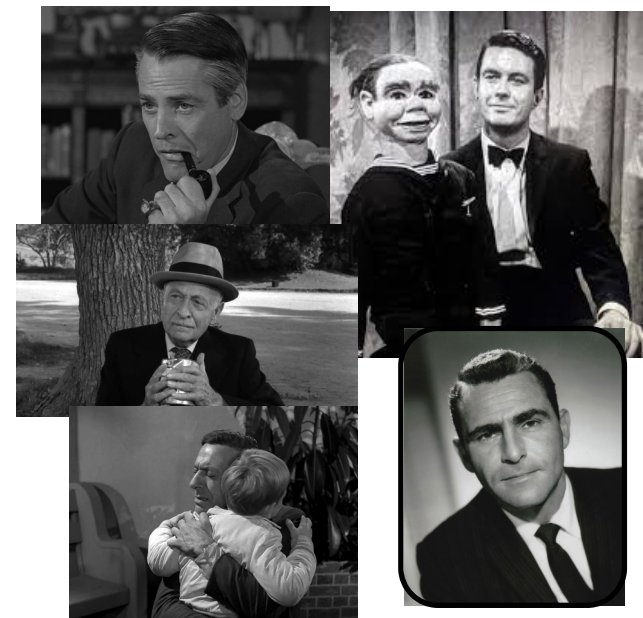

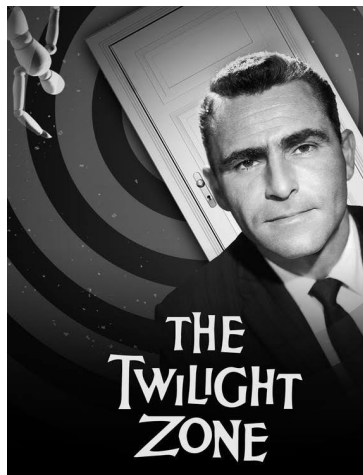
## About Live Well, Age Smart
